2005 TRAINING CONTRACT

We are dedicated to providing you 100% satisfaction with the training your horse receives. We have strict guidelines we follow for producing maximum effect during the time your horse is with us "in school". Whether training for the green horse, schooling the experienced horse, or learning a new discipline, both you and your horse will benefit from our education!

We bring your horse into our stable for five days. During this stay, you are not obligated to buy our services. We will assess your horses' current knowledge and suitability for the discipline which you wish trained. Should we believe the horse not ready for, or not capable of, learning this discipline, your horse will be returned to you with a written evaluation at no charge to you!

Should your horse be ready and able to learn the discipline you chose, we will be able to give you an estimate on the length of time needed to complete the training. Horses learn at different rates. Should your horse quickly pick up on the training, your horse will be "graduated" at an earlier date and you are not obligated to pay for any time not used. Should your horse require more time, you will be notified during the weekly lesson and an extension on the agreed upon time will need to be reviewed.

The green (unbroke) horse.

We start on the ground with voice commands, de-sensitivity lessons, and manners. Usually 60-90 days from unbroke to riding the trail.

The educated horse learning a new discipline

Most horses, already well trained, can learn a new discipline in 30 days. We can finish the education here with an additional 30 days or allow you to take your horse home and complete the education.

We require the owner to be fully involved in the training process. Included in the training cost is 4 lessons (one per week of the month) with your horse. This is to ensure you are familiar with what we are doing as well as what your horse has learned.

What we train (both horse and rider):

1. Pleasure riding (english or western)
2. Trail experience
3. Pleasure driving (single)
4. Carriage driving (single) - call for driving double rates and availability
5. Conditioning (for endurance or track)
6. Retraining Rehab for "bad" horses

Our rates (For 2005)

1. \$250 per month for training
2. \$265 per month for the board (full care includes turnout, grooming, clipping and bathing). A boarding contract is necessary.
3. **No other hidden costs!** The owner is responsible for farrier, vet, worming, and other "boarding" related costs as per the boarding agreement. We will haul your horse within a 25 mile radius of us for free (to and from our barn for training).
