DETAILS: Ride is 25 miles through the old strip mines located east of historical Hazelton, PA. The ride is sanctioned by ECTRA and will be conducted according to the rules and regulations set forth by ECTRA. All riders are expected to be familiar with these rules found on the ECTRA website www.ectra.org. Helmets are required.

AWARDS: All riders that complete will receive a completion award. Two divisions HW and LW and a junior division will receive awards for 1st through 6th place. There will be other awards for breeds as well as some awards for silly things you'll have to guess about.

CAMPING: Rough camping at Freeland Kennel Club, no electric. Outside toilet facilities. NO FIRES! Cost per rig, \$10. Space is limited, please buddy up with someone if you can. Please take your manure and trash home with you after the ride. Bring water, limited water is available in the camp.

FOOD: Coffee and donuts will be available in the morning of the ride for the riders and volunteers. A barbeque will be available after the ride during the award ceremony for all riders and volunteers. On trail snacks and beverages will be available to riders.

ELIGIBILITY: According to ECTRA rules, the ride is open to all equines aged 48 months or older. A negative coggins test must accompany the entry application.

TRAIL/HOLDS: The trails are easy, with a couple small climbs and descents. There will be one hold in base camp. One 12.5 mile loop done twice will make up the 25 mile ride. There is limited water on the trail so we are asking each rider to bring a large tub for water, put your name on it, so that we may put them out along the trail for your horses. Several rocky trails, shoes recommended.

Go 4.6 miles and make a right on Buck Mountain Road. Go approx. 1.1 miles and make a left on S Railroad. Go approx 2/10 of a mile and you will see the Freeland Kennel Club sign on your right.
